

# >>> Register by March 1 to Meet Eligibility Requirements

The national SkillsUSA membership deadline is **March 1**. Student members must meet both their state deadline and the March 1 national membership deadline to be eligible for national competitions; to serve as voting delegates; to run for national office; or to apply for national scholarships, awards and honors.
