To encourage youth to develop and implement sustainable hunger-relief programs in their community, Youth Service America (YSA) is partnering with the Sodexo Stop Hunger Foundation to launch the new <u>Youth</u> <u>Stop Hunger Innovation Grant</u>. Twelve \$2,500 grants will be awarded to cohorts of youth between the ages of 5 and 25 years old who are fighting hunger in their community by addressing its root causes, while also engaging other youth in volunteerism. Applications are open through **Dec. 8**.

The National Youth Leadership Council Youth Leadership for Service-Learning Excellence Award recognizes K-12 service-learning programs and projects that demonstrate outstanding youth leadership with a focus on high-quality service-learning and having a sustainable impact on the participants and the broader community. Youth teams representing K-12 in which the service-learning is tied to the school curricula may apply.
